

## HOW TO FIND US:



The **WELCOMECENTER HESSEN** is situated in the offices of the Agentur für Arbeit Frankfurt am Main (Employment Agency) in close proximity to the city center of Frankfurt.

The closest stops for public transport are **Konstablerwache** (city train lines (S-Bahn) S1–S6, S8, S9; Metro lines U4–U7), **Dom/Römer** (U4 and U5), **Börneplatz** (tram lines 11, 12; bus lines 30, 36), **Schöne Aussicht** (bus lines 30 and 36), **Hospital zum Heiligen Geist** (tram lines 14 and 18).

If you travel by car follow Kurt-Schumacher-Straße to Rechneigrabenstraße and then Schützenstraße. Coming from Schöne Aussicht, follow Mainstraße, then Rechneigrabenstraße and Schützenstraße. From the north, follow Lange Straße (Cityring) until you reach your destination in Fischerfeldstraße.

Parking is located in Fischerfeldstraße. We recommend using public transport if possible as the parking facilities are limited.
